#### Appropriate clothing

#### **Behaviour**

WAC is separate from the school, however, the rules of behavior and appropriate language used, still apply. We do not use the traffic light system as we want the club to have a different feel to school, however, we still expect the same appropriate behavior and respect given to staff, other children, and the resources in WAC. Please can I ask that you talk to your child about this. We will always inform you if there have been problems during a session.









#### Allergies and intolerances

We always check this based on the information that is given to the office, but if there are any changes, please do keep this up to date so that we can provide the best care and safety for your child.

#### First Aid trained staff

There is always a member of staff in each session that is First Aid / Paediatric First Aid trained. This is always kept up to date for all staff.

### **Booking Early request**

Can you please ensure that if you require a space at WAC for your child you book as soon as possible through the parent platform or the school office. We run in a 1:8 ratio and always have 2 members of staff in. We are very pleased to see the club being used and developing but unfortunately this has led to some people not having a space on the days they wanted. If we reach our full capacity, we can usually get additional staff in with enough notice. However, if we have unexpected children arrive, we cannot guarantee this last minute. If this happens and no staff are available, unfortunately, we cannot take your child in, and the office will have no choice but to phone home to arrange pick up. Sorry for any inconvenience. We do understand that things can happen at the last minute, but the sooner that your child is booked in, the sooner staffing can be arranged.

If you no longer require the space for your child, please could you phone or email the office to let them know as soon as possible, there have been cases when staff have been frantically searching for children who have been booked in but already picked up.

Upon arriving and leaving WAC, it is vital that you wait outside the gate until your child is collected and brought to you, please do not open the gate, and invite yourself in. Only staff are permitted to open and close the gate to ensure that the gate is safely closed to keep boundaries secured and children safe.
